**Gracie Mansion** (Federal style, 1799): New York City mayor's residence since 1942  
**Metropolitan Museum of Art**: lunch break and Hudson River School galleries

### Wednesday • May 16

**Morris-Jumel Mansion** (1765): New York City's oldest house  
**Ever Rest Jasper Cropsey Home & Studio** (Greek Revival, 1882): key figure of Hudson River School  
**Sunnyside** (1835): Sleepy Hollow home of Washington Irving  
**Union Church**, Pocantico Hills: short stop to see Chagall and Matisse  
Hotel check-in (3 nights, continental breakfast included daily): **Beekman Arms/Delamater Inn** (1766)  
Dinner at **Tavern** at **Beekman Arms**

### Thursday • May 17

**Boscobel** (1804): superb Adamesque house and furnishings  
**West Point** (1802): historic views, tour, and lunch in gracious **Thayer Hotel** (1926)  
**Locust Grove** (1850): home of painter-turned-inventor Samuel F. B. Morse  
Poughkeepsie: **Vassar College's Frances Loeb Art Center**

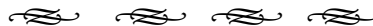
### Friday • May 18

**Edgewater** (1825): first colonnaded Greek Revival house, home to Gore Vidal, Richard Jenrette  
**FDR Presidential Library & Museum**: tour after lunch on your own in **Uncle Sam's Canteen**;  
**Springwood FDR Mansion** (1826)  
**Vanderbilt Mansion** (1895): Gilded Age country mansion, designed by McKim, Mead & White  
Dinner at **Culinary Institute of America**



### Saturday • May 19

**Cedar Grove** (1815): home and studio of Hudson River School founder, Thomas Cole  
**Olana** (1870): Persian villa of Hudson River painter Frederic Edwin Church – picnic and tour  
**Albany Institute of History & Art** (1791, America's oldest museum): focus on Hudson River School collection  
Albany airport for return flights



Historic Hotels: 2 nights in New York City at the **Warwick Hotel**  
3 nights at **Delamater Inn** (1766), Rhinebeck, designed by Alexander Jackson Davis

Other inclusions: Porterage, 5 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 3 dinners, all ground transportation (chartered coach daily),  
museum admissions, guides and gratuities; commentary throughout by Austin art historian Karen Pope;  
travel protection
